

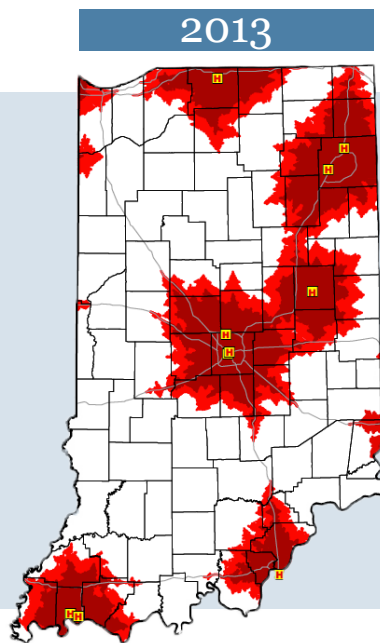
Level III Trauma

Trauma is the leading cause of death for individuals up to 45 years old and the 4th leading cause of death overall. In the United States, more than three million non-fatal injuries occur per year.

Good Samaritan is committed to treating patients with injuries by the establishment of a Level III Trauma Center designated by the State of Indiana. Our highly trained trauma team is promptly available to provide optimal care to an injured patient.

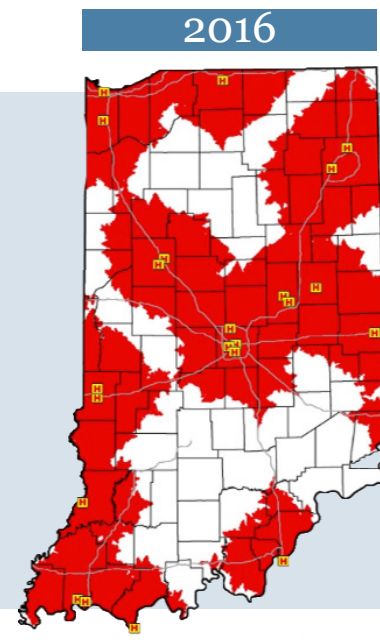
What is the goal of a trauma center?

Before Good Samaritan Trauma Services

Since 2013, more than 1,000 patients have been treated by the Good Samaritan Trauma Team. Working closely with our five Centers of Excellence, (Surgical Services, Orthopedics, Obstetrics, Oncology and Cardiology), we have been able to treat 83% of injured patients close to home in Vincennes.

Who makes up the trauma team?

The Good Samaritan trauma team consists of highly trained general surgeons, emergency medicine physicians, orthopedic surgeons, anesthesiologists, nurses, radiology, laboratory, respiratory therapists, social workers, physical therapists and emergency medical services.
